

2013 FULL YEAR REQUIREMENTS INFORMATION

ALL returning Roster Artists are required to complete the following actions:

- a. Residency Requirement
- b. Professional Development Action
- c. FULL update to online roster profile
- d. Submission of Signature Page

DESCRIPTION OF REQUIREMENTS

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT

This action requires completion of ONE residency program and submission of documentation in the form of a teacher/staff evaluation. Projects must have taken place within the three years since the last residency requirement deadline (September 1, 2010 – September 1, 2013).

Artists listed in both the Education and Community tracks need only submit documentation of one residency, however the residency submitted must have taken place in a preK-12, education-based setting.

- Submit the FIELD EVALUATION REPORT or your own teacher/staff evaluation form.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT ACTION

This action requires completion of a Professional Development Action related to the field of Teaching Artistry.

For Education Based Roster Artists, professional development must pertain to work in preK-12, education-based settings.

- Submit the PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT ACTION FORM.

FULL UPDATE TO ONLINE ROSTER PROFILE

This action requires a FULL update to your online roster profile.

The full update to your online roster profile requires you re-engage with your online materials and narrative responses, complete new sections of the tracks and upload any new required materials in order to remain on the Teaching Artist Roster. The specific information needed to complete this requirement will be made available in May 2013.

- Complete a FULL UPDATE TO YOUR ONLINE ROSTER PROFILE.

SUBMISSION OF SIGNATURE PAGE

This action requires submission of the Teaching Artist Roster Signature Page.

- Submit the TEACHING ARTIST ROSTER SIGNATURE PAGE.
