1. Be considerate and respectful of others. Vulgarity, threats or abuse of language will not be tolerated.
2. Differing opinions and discussion of diverse ideas are encouraged, but personal attacks on anyone, including Arts Commission staff, will not be permitted.
3. Share freely and be generous, but be aware of copyright laws; be accurate and give credit where credit is due.
4. Stay on topic.
5. Refrain from using the Facebook page for solicitation, for commercial purposes or to market products.
